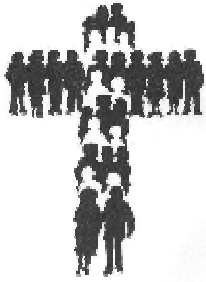

SERVICE

Participants are divided into two work teams and go out into the community to make necessary repairs to substandard homes. They work Monday through Friday repairing roofs, replacing rotted siding, painting homes, and building wheelchair ramps, among several other projects. Our worksites are often referrals from Gadsden County agencies and social workers. All work is done free of cost to the homeowners as a gift of love and compassion in the name of Christ. In addition to the work done on the home, work teams minister to the homeowners and residents of the neighborhood. We also provide vacation bible school supplies for the children in the neighborhood to learn about Jesus. Poverty is not just a problem in third-world countries, people are suffering only miles from where we live.

BACKGROUND

Love At Work is a growing mission project endorsed by the Florida Conference of the United Methodist Church and supported through Killearn UMC in Tallahassee. Over the years what was established in 1993 as purely a construction project designed to help residents of nearby Gadsden County who reside in substandard housing has grown into a multidimensional mission effort to help the residents in all areas of life. But we can not do it alone. There is more need than we can meet on our own. Join us as we bring hope to the hopeless in the name of Christ.

MISSION STATEMENT

The core mission of Love At Work is to encourage spiritual growth in youth through service to others.

STATEMENT OF FAITH

We believe that there is one God, eternally existent and revealed in three persons; Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. We believe that God is personal, transcendent and is the sovereign Creator of all things. We believe that the Bible is the inspired word of God and through it the plan of salvation is revealed in the blood and grace of Jesus Christ. Love at Work shares this message through serving those in need and encouraging spiritual growth in youth through this outreach.

AT CAMP

Participants are housed at Centenary Camp. The camp has two dorms that each sleep 44 people, a main dining hall/worship area, a recreational field, basketball and volleyball courts, and swimming pool. Each morning participants pray, eat breakfast, have quiet time, then pack up and head to the worksites. After returning to the camp in mid afternoon they will have a chance to swim in the pool, participate in competitive games, and enjoy Christian fellowship through free time. After dinner the campers break up into their individual work groups and talk



about their experience on the worksite, the devotionals, and what the speaker discussed the previous night. After these small group meetings everyone returns into the dining hall where they worship the Lord with our worship band, and learn more about Christ's plan for their lives.
